Day 2

Breakfast at the hotel

Take a morning excursion to the Kona Cloud Forest Sanctuary for a 3 hour hiking tour. The group will discover what a Tropical Cloud Forest really is; how it benefits the ecosystem and the story of its development on the slopes of Hualalai. This experience will include the amazing ferns, palms, flowers, and hundreds of exotic and native species of birds

Lunch, on own

Enjoy an afternoon tour and in-depth look at one of the many coffee plantations/farms on the Big Island. During these tours you are shown around the plantation to see the growing coffee in the field. Then you are taken through the processes that are needed to go from a growing coffee bean to a cup of coffee (drying, processing, and roasting). This tour will end with a tasting of the coffee.

Next visit Pu'uhonua O Hōnaunau, the "place of refuge" - a part of ancient Hawaii where breaking the law was punishable by death. This visit will offer an in depth look at the grounds of this National Historic Park

Evening dinner included at a local restaurant

Enjoy a nighttime hands on astronomy workshop including details of stars, planets, and constellations. View all these sights through an 18 inch telescope with presentation commentary throughout

Day 3


Breakfast at the hotel

Take a stop at Punalu'u Black Sand Beach and learn how the beach was formed by hot lava entering the ocean, exploding and latter cooling to form basalt black sand. There will also be time to explore the volcanic reef and see endangered Hawksbill and Green Sea Turtles basking in the sun.

Next enter Volcanoes National Park and head directly to the Thurston Lava Tube. The tube is located in the middle of a giant tropical hapu'u fern forest. Explore the 300ft. cavern where lava flowed thousands of years ago and use a flash light to go even deeper where light disappears. After there will be a mile long hike on Devastation Trail and learn about the two types of lava found in Hawaii

Deli style lunch at the visitors center while viewing a large typographical map of the big island and learning of the tectonic plates and Ring of Fire





Continue after lunch to visit the steam vents and the Jagger Museum which where live seismographs record live earthquakes below. The day will conclude with a lava lake at Halemaumau Crater and a stop at Rainbow Falls Evening local style dinner

Day 4

Morning at leisure

Depart for Keahou Bay and board the Fairwinds Snorkel Cruise to Historic Kealakekua Bay where Hawaii was first discovered by Captain Cook in 1777. Explore lava tubes, see sea turtles, spinner dolphins and possibly a humpback whale or two. On board and you have use of snorkel equipment, water toys, floating trampoline, water slide and dive platform.

Day 7


